In our opinion, any design or style of canopy always has room for improvement. For example, by continuing the angle of windscreen through to the canopy front panel, this will visually improve the aesthetics as well as enhance the aero-dynamics.

With this in mind, we have researched and developed new and improved techniques in to manufacturing more innovative and versatile styles of canopy to suit both classic and modern designs of power craft.

Our forward and aft canopies are produced using a UV stable and shower resistant acrylic canvas. This acrylic canvas is available in a wide range of colours enabling easy co-ordination to your craft. Industry standard stainless steel tubing is utilised in the construction of all supporting framework.

Optional extras can be included to further enhance our standard specification on both forward and aft canopies. Some examples of these optional extras are detailed here and overleaf.

- By inserting extra window panels in to the canopies this will improve the appearance, offer more internal light and general all round vision.
- By simply adding quality nylon zips, the front, side and rear panels can then be completely removed providing improved flexibility in converting your waterproof enclosure in to a Bimini style sun shade.
